Patrick Oliver, Ph.D. '74

Patrick Oliver served for many years as a law enforcement executive. He possesses a Bachelor of Arts degree in Criminal Justice from Baldwin Wallace College; a Master's degree in Business Administration from Baldwin Wallace College; and a PhD in Leadership and Change from Antioch University in Yellow Springs, Ohio. Dr. Oliver is a graduate of the FBI's Law Enforcement Executive Development School and a graduate of Ohio Association Chiefs of Police Executive Leadership College.

Patrick's law enforcement experience is distinguished. He served as Chief of Police for the City of Fairborn, Ohio Police Department and the City of Grandview Heights, Ohio. He also served as Interim Chief of Police for the Village of Lincoln Heights, Ohio. Patrick served as a Trooper for the Ohio State Highway Patrol. He was Ranger Chief for the Cleveland Metropolitan Park District and was the first African American Chief of Police for the City of Cleveland.

Patrick was an instructor at Cuyahoga Community College in law enforcement and business. He served as an adjunct professor in the College of Urban Affairs at Wright State University and served as a faculty mentor for a Ph.D. student at Antioch University. Dr. Oliver is currently an Associate Professor and Director of the Criminal Justice Program at Cedarville University. Patrick has been an instructor at the International Law Enforcement Academy for students from six African Nations in Botswana in 2012. He has been a member of the Ohio Criminal Justice Exchange Program with Brazil and the Turkish National Police.

Patrick is the author of many articles and publications. He has recently written articles regarding the recruitment and retention of law enforcement officers. Cities and counties in Ohio and across the country struggle to maintain a full staff of police officers since

the COVID pandemic. Patrick wrote a series of articles for the Ohio Police Chief Magazine entitled "Law Enforcement Recruitment, Why it Matters and Key Management Decisions." Patrick penned an article entitled "Lifelong Leadership and Service Grounded in Biblical Truth" for the Cedarville Magazine. Patrick contributed an article in 2020 to WEWS-TV in Cleveland, "Calling for Tougher Police Licensing Requirements." He has written articles regarding the recruitment of minority police officers, the management of multicultural law enforcement agencies and the importance of community-based policing. In 2020-2022, Patrick was selected and served as the lead consultant by Ohio Governor Mike DeWine for the Office of Law Enforcement Recruitment.

Patrick is the past president of the Ohio Association of Chiefs of Police. He is the founder and Director of the National Organization of Black Law Enforcement Executives Mentor Program for aspiring police chiefs. He served for nine years as a commissioner for the Commission on Accreditation for Law Enforcement Agencies, the international accreditation body for law enforcement agencies. He serves on several community organizations including Chair of the Budget and Finance Committee of First Baptist Church in Fairborn, Ohio and is a board member for Hope Rising, a pregnancy resource center in the Dayton, Ohio area.

Patrick met his wife, Kim, while they were both employed at Cleveland Metroparks. Kim was the Lead Birdkeeper at the zoo. They have been married for 27 years and have three children. Brittney is 25 and is a 3rd grade school teacher. Jason is 21 and is an electrician apprentice. Justin is 20 and a sophomore management major at Cedarville University.

Patrick has two brothers, Jim, Jr. '72 and Mike '74 who also attended Cathedral Latin School.

FAREWELL PARTY FOR Sue Wise - Saturday, July 26

After 24+ years of dedicated service, Sue Wise, Cathedral Latin Alumni Secretary, announced her retirement. Words cannot adequately describe the accolades that she so richly deserves.

Sue has played a major role in the running of our alumni association. She was the glue that held us all together. She has worked tirelessly on many tasks, events, reunions and projects for our association. Sue has handled the everyday tasks of handling all communication via phone, text or email, handling the mail, maintaining the database & website, notifying classmates of deaths, processing all financial transactions, coordinating and running the annual events, supporting class luncheons/reunions, publishing the *Alumnotes*, distributing the dues mailing and dues collections and assisting classes with their reunions.

She has spoken over the phone or personally met a large majority of our alums. As our alums have aged and the number of trustees has declined, Sue has stepped up to play larger, more prominent roles in all our events and projects.

Darryl Orlando Ledbetter '80 2024 Bill Nunn Memorial Award

D. Orlando Ledbetter, who writes about the Atlanta Falcons for *The Atlanta Journal-Constitution* and has covered the NFL since the late 1980s, was selected as the 2024 Bill Nunn Memorial Award winner by the Professional Football Writers of America (PFWA) in May 2024.



Ledbetter, the 56th Nunn Award honoree, is the first journalist who primarily worked at *The Atlanta Journal-Constitution* to win the award. The Nunn Award is given to a reporter who has made a long and distinguished contribution to pro football through coverage. The award is named for Nunn, who prior to his Hall of Fame scouting career with the Pittsburgh Steelers worked for 22 years at the *Pittsburgh Courier*, one of the most influential Black publications in the United States. He was elected to the Hall in the Contributor category in 2021, and later that year the annual award from the PFWA was renamed in his honor.

On August 2, 2024, Ledbetter was honored by the Pro Football Hall of Fame in Canton, Ohio, as part of Enshrinement Week.

"I am honored and humbled to be named as the Nunn Award winner this year, and it is always wonderful to be cited by a group of your peers. As a product of an HBCU at Howard, it is a particular pleasure to me to receive an award named for Bill Nunn Jr.," Ledbetter said. "It has been an honor to serve the Pro Football Writers of America as a vice president, president and member of the board over the past several years. It is a joy to cover the NFL along with the people and stories that make the game what it is today."

Ledbetter joined *The Atlanta Journal Constitution* in 2003 and moved to the Falcons beat in 2005. During his time covering the Falcons, he was one of the lead writers in the newspaper's coverage of the Michael Vick dog fighting federal case in 2007 and covered the Falcons' run to the NFC title and a berth in Super Bowl LI. He also hosts a podcast: *The Bow Tie Chronicles*.

"This award affirms what we in Atlanta have known for years," said Leroy Chapman, *The Atlanta Journal-Constitution* editor-in-chief. "Darryl is an extraordinary talent and a first-rate journalist. He belongs in Canton."

Among Ledbetter's other professional honors, he was selected as the 2022 Georgia Co-Sportswriter of the Year by the National Sports Media Association to go with three Associated Press Sports Editors writing awards and a PFWA Dick Connor Writing Awards category first-place honor while covering the Falcons and the NFL.

Prior to Atlanta, Ledbetter spent eight years (1992-2000) at the *Milwaukee Journal Sentinel*, seven as a writer covering the Green Bay Packers, the NBA's Milwaukee Bucks and Marquette University basketball, and his final year as a columnist.

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Martin Raxton, Class of 1982

Martin sits on the Board of Directors for the Michigan State University Black Alumni which administers \$3.1 million in endowed scholarships for students. Martin serves as Chairman of the Bylaws Committee and is a member of the Nominating Committee. Under his stewardship, he has obtained Board approval modifying bylaws impacting voting procedures, officer qualifications and financial reporting requirements for chapters. Martin is the President & CEO of the Krimson Political Action Council, LLC, serving as the strategy and marketing officer where he successfully increased donor contributions by 35% for 60 candidates seeking elected offices at the local, state and federal levels.

Martin has served as Vice Chair of the Douglas County Board of Assessors making decisions

impacting property values on 54,000 personal and commercial properties in Douglas County, Georgia that directly support the Douglas County's annual budget. He also is a Founder and President of the Delta Pi Foundation dba the Michigan State University Achievement Fund which is a non-profit foundation charged with raising capital from individual and corporate donors to support academic and need based scholarships. Martin is a past Chairman of the City of Douglasville Planning & Zoning Board rendering decisions on zoning variance requests leading to economic development and construction job creation. In June 2024, he was elected the first African-American male Commissioner of District 3 representing 35,000 residents in Douglas County, Georgia. In his current capacity, Martin serves as the Chairman of the Benefits Committee and Pensions Committee supporting the needs of the 1,200 employees of Douglas County.

As a 25-year strategic portfolio and program executive, Martin has created new innovations impacting customers through information technology. He has presented new strategic initiatives to corporate boards and senior executives in the energy, hospitality, insurance and fintech space. Currently, Martin is employed with Cisco as a portfolio operation lead supporting multiple component families within Cisco IT. Prior to Cisco, he worked at NCR as a senior program director

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within digital banking guiding the development of enterprise level strategic products shifting the competitive advantages of the company from ATM machines to Software as a Service (SaaS) while expanding the footprint of cryptocurrency, online banking and mobile applications which directly supports hundreds of financial institutions. His governance experience includes private sector and public policy legislation presented to elected officials on strategic initiatives regarding affordable housing and business development to local and state jurisdictions.

Martin is a Herndon Directors Institute fellow and holds a Master of Public Administration degree from Cleveland State University's Maxine Goodman Levin College of Urban Affairs and a bachelor's degree in Organization/Industrial Psychology from Michigan State University. He has also completed coursework towards a doctorate degree in Public Administration from Florida Atlantic University. He holds several professional certifications including an Advanced Master's Certificate in Project Management from George Washington University, Program for Technical Managers from the Georgia Institute of Technology, Project Management Professional (PMP), Project Management Institute Agile Certified Practitioner (PMI-ACP) and Certified Scrum Master (CSM).

In his spare time, Martin enjoys reading, traveling, golf, investing, presenting at community forums and mentoring future leaders.

Ledbetter worked for seven years (1985-1992) with the *Cincinnati Enquirer*, covering the Cincinnati Bengals, Ohio State football and basketball, and high school sports. He started his journalism career at the *Charlotte Observer* (1984-86), writing about high school athletics.

During his time in Cincinnati, Ledbetter graduated with a Juris Doctorate from the University of Cincinnati College of Law in 1990. After moving to Milwaukee, he passed the State Bar of Wisconsin and became a practicing attorney while writing for the *Journal-Sentinel*. He has also practiced law in the Atlanta area.

He is currently an adjunct professor at the University of Georgia's Carmichael Sports Media Institute, was an adjunct professor at Clark Atlanta University and has lectured at the Marquette University National Sports Law Institute.

Born in St. Louis, Ledbetter moved to Cleveland in middle school. He graduated from Howard University in 1984 with a degree in print journalism. He is a longtime member of the Pro Football Hall of Fame Selection Committee, including the Hall's Seniors Committee. He served as the 26th president of the Pro Football Writers of America during the 2013-14 seasons.
